## OUTDOOR MEETINGS AT THE SERENITY CENTER DURING COVID-19 CRISIS DURING DAYLIGHT HOURS

Outdoor meetings have been approved by the Howard County Health Department, with the following restrictions:

- 1. There is no limit on the number of people but proper social distancing of 6 ft separation minimum must be practiced. Use of masks is strongly encouraged by the Health Department.
- 2. Each meeting attendee must bring their own chairs. Chairs from inside TSC cannot be used.
- 3. For contact tracing, the Secretary/Leader must make a list of <u>first names and phone numbers of the meeting attendees and the date of the meeting.</u>
  This is to facilitate any contact tracing that may be needed, in the event that an attendee tests positive for COVID-19. This protects all the attendees. The Secretary/Leader should keep the list for 6 weeks, or so, and then it can be destroyed. The Secretary/Leader must provide their contact information to The Serenity Center, <u>info@theserenitycentercolumbia.org</u>. This practice is from the guidelines set by the Baltimore AA Intergroup for small group meetings during the COVID-19 crisis.
- 4. The Serenity Center is closed. Bathrooms are available from 9:00-11:15am and 1:15-4:00pm. Only one person at-a-time can enter the building to use the bathrooms.
